Requirements are:

- Must be a current High School Senior.

- Must provide copy of High School Transcript.
- Must submit completed, signed application form and typed essays.

All applications must be returned to the Daniel P. Hurd School directed to the attention of the PTO Scholarship Committee by the deadline.
